



# NCFCA State Representative Information Qualifications and Job Description

## Qualifications

1. Agree with the Statement of Faith as listed in the NCFCA Bylaws.
2. Commit to uphold the NCFCA Mission Statement as listed in the NCFCA Bylaws.  
*The National Christian Forensics and Communications Association (NCFCA) believes that formal speech and debate can provide a means for home schooled students to learn and exercise analytical and oratorical skills, addressing life issues from a Biblical worldview in a manner that glorifies God. To provide these opportunities to home schooled students, NCFCA shall facilitate qualifying tournaments throughout the country and the annual National Championship.*
3. Demonstrate an organizational commitment to NCFCA (league parent, coach, or alumni).
4. Participated in NCFCA at least two seasons and remained an NCFCA Affiliate in good standing.
5. Abide by NCFCA Bylaws and currently published rules and policies.
6. Attend orientation or other training opportunities as specified by the Board.

## Job Description

1. Actively advocate for and support NCFCA policies and procedures to Affiliates in their state.
2. Serve Affiliates in their state as the NCFCA first point of contact for questions and concerns.
3. Strive to represent NCFCA at each tournament in their state and ensure that Qualifying Tournaments are run in accordance with NCFCA rules and policies.
4. Represent the needs and concerns of Affiliates to the NCFCA organizational structure.
5. Serve for a two-year term.
6. Participate with other State Representatives (SR) in their region to submit nominations to the Board for a Regional Coordinator (RC) and then to subsequently vote for RC.
7. Assist the RC with oversight of Qualifying Tournaments and the accuracy of all tournament documentation (both before and after the tournament).

## Nominations

1. The State Representative candidate must be nominated by an Affiliate in their state.
2. The nomination will be forwarded from the SR candidate to NCFCA with a brief (4 to 6 line) biography pertinent to service as an SR.
3. The nomination period will normally occur in the April/May time frame to coincide with the expiration of each state's staggered 2-year term.
